

Patient Organisations Transfer of Value Disclosure

Daiichi Sankyo UK Ltd 2021- 2023

Methodological note and the transparency data for payments made by Daiichi Sankyo UK (DSUK) to Patient Organisations, in accordance with the ABPI Code of Practice for the Pharmaceutical Industry (the ABPI Code) for the calendar years 2021 to 2023. The purpose of disclosing ToV is to ensure transparency in the relationships between pharmaceutical companies and patient organisations, preventing any potential conflicts of interest and promoting ethical interactions.

- **Transfer of Value** (ToV) refers to any direct or indirect transfer of financial or non-financial benefits provided by a DSUK to a patient organisation. This may be in the form of monetary payments, in-kind contributions, or other benefits that have a tangible value.
- **Patient organisation** means an organisation mainly comprising of patients and/or caregivers or any user organisation such as a disability organisation, carer or relative organisation and consumer organisation that represents and/or supports the needs of patients and/or caregivers.
- **Support** categories provided to patient organisations may include Sponsorship of events (e.g., educational meetings, conferences). Donations and grants (e.g., funding for specific projects or initiatives). Joint working (e.g., collaborative projects aimed at improving patient outcomes). Service provision (e.g., consultancy services, speaker engagements). A brief description of the nature of the support is provided with each disclosure.
- **Cross-border Interactions:** DSUK will disclose any ToV made to patient organisations based in the UK, even when the support is initiated by other affiliates.
- **Currency** - Where payments were made in a currency other than pound sterling (GBP), the exchange rate will vary according to the date the conversion calculation was made.
- **Value Added Tax** - this is not included in the amount disclosed
